Relevant Dates

24th October 1857 - Sheffield FC were founded. They are said to be the world's oldest football club

The oldest football ground is Sandygate, owned by Hallam FC in Sheffield. The first competitive game played at the ground was against Sheffield Football Club on 26 Dec 1860.

Friday 23rd July 2021 - The Opening Ceremony to begin the Olympic Games in Tokyo, Japan.

1896 - The first modern Olympic Games held in Athens, Greece.

776BC - The first ancient Olympic Games held in Olympia, Greece.

Key Facts

- *The oldest football ground in the world - Sandygate - can be found in Sheffield and is home to Hallam FC
- * Sheffield FC are said to be the world's oldest football club
- * Sheffield hosted the World Student Games in 1991 and built facilities like Don Valley Stadium, Ponds Forge, Sheffield Arena and Hillsborough Leisure Centre
- * How sounds are made: Sounds are made when objects vibrate.
- * Volume of a sound: The louder the sound, the bigger the vibration. The closer you are to the source of a sound, the louder the sound will be. The further away you are from the source of a sound, the quieter the sound will be.
- * Pitch of A Sound: The pitch of a sound is how high or low it is. The shorter the object the higher the pitch. The longer the object the lower the pitch.

* How Does Sound Travel? Sound can travel through solids, liquids and gases. Sound travels as a wave, vibrating the particles in the medium it is travelling in.
