Hellos & Goodbyes



New Dinner Menu & Price Increase



A new dinner menu will be served after the Easter holidays, commencing with week 1 on the 17th April 2023. Children will be given a paper copy and the new menu will also be available to view from the home page of our website. Unfortunately, due to the

significant rise in costs, the price of school dinners will rise by 10p to £2.30, which is £11.50 weekly.

Free School Meals - Reminder

You can claim free school meals for a child who lives with you and who you are responsible for. Your claim will be automatically processed if you receive Housing Benefit or Council Tax Reduction and get any of the qualifying benefits.

Eligibility

Your child is eligible for Free School Meals if you get one or more of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit. Provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit, and have an annual gross income, of no more than £16,190 (as of 2014 financial year) as assessed by His Majesty's Revenue and Customs
- Working Tax Credit run-on. Paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
